1) Fundraising

- **Spirit Nights-**
 - **Mteacher night-** least amount from past years (maybe bc of cold and wind?) \$326 brought in. Next one in April.
 - **California Tortilla** in February 25% back but you do need to mention Brooke.
 - **Brusters** guest scooper night in March
- **Read-a-thon-** reached our reading mins goal. Mrs Detwiler and MRs Houtz top 2 classrooms. Movie day before break. Recess game packs to come.
- **Spirit Sticks-** Valentine bags to get rid of inventory. Will include a bunch in a bag with a note to fill out.
- **Spiritwear-** some leftover in the closet, Holiday Shopper flash sale \$125; sales online at least 50% down from last year. We got \$100 back to H&S from the company.

2) Community Events

- **Holiday Shoppe recap -** timing was a lot better this year than past years. Maybe look into a new vendor, but this current vendor is so easy with no shipping costs and not checking inventory. Made \$550. Same timing for next year if available.
- **Book fair-** very happy with how things went. Least successful book fair but not because of the company, instead, there just were not a lot of people coming through the doors to look around and buy. People were still happy with things when they came in, just less families. Better selection, cleaner set up. In the future, don't have at the same time as the read-a-thon. Maybe have it before the read-a-thon so less overwhelming to families. \$5389 total sales, \$208 as book profit for Mrs Deangelis at reduced cost, took in \$419 in cash, \$523 literati partner credits which

we can use online for more books, indoor recess games, can also use money on other products from other companies (might need more more rewards for that though).

- Spring book fair during the art show. Run weds, thurs, fri instead so more parents can come. 4/22-4/24 (art show is the 22nd)
- Coin drive- challenge for each grade K/1, 2, 3, 4 and can earn an extra recess (K will get a recess). 4 bins out in the lobb.
- Julie would like a co-chair.
- Treats by the track paired with the book fair in mid september??? Or back to school night week?? Will see if Literati has availability then.

• **Bingo Night/Basket Raffle** - really good shape. \$3000 in sponsors, 70 community donations (experiences, electronics, tickets, camps, etc). Pre-orders going on now, \$10 for sheet. Buy 5 sheets, get 1 free. Buy 10 sheets, get 3 sheets free. Pre-order pick up on 1/29 at 6pm. Bingo night 1/30 at 6:30pm.

- **Color Fun Run**- materials going home on color wars feb 20th or 23rd, fundraising starts 23rd. Incentive- stickers this year (for water bottles, books, etc) for registrations, raise \$25- 2 extra packs of colors, \$75- hw passes, \$150 for specials pass (will talk to teachers), \$250- color changing water bottle. \$25 gift card to teacher with the highest registration amount per grade level. Popsicle party for highest class registrations. \$20,000 goal school wide- fun hat/headband day. Goggles to buy as an option still. Working to get Kona Ice. doughnut truck ?? look into banner instead of yard signs since we have had bad luck lately. Have DJ announce the class pictures, announce before the run starts, signs with times of when pictures happen to increase the number of families who stay so bigger class pictures are taken.
- **Yearbook** - sales are moving along really well. Promo right now, if 50 sold by end of
